



2022 Sunday Series Notice of Race

1. RULES

This series will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. The Sunday Series is open to Nyack Boat Club members and guests. There will be *starts* for the PHRF, Ensign, Laser, Lightning, Open, Sonar, and Thistle classes.

2.2. All PHRF boats must have a current HRYRA PHRF certificate.

2.3. All boats must display a sail number per RRS Appendix G.

3. FEES

There are no separate fees for the Sunday Series.

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. Races are scheduled every Sunday from 5/18/2022 through 10/16/2022, except for NBC club regattas on 5/29/22, 7/10/22, and 9/12/22.

4.2. The scheduled time of the warning signal for PHRF racing is 1330, except for 10/16/22, Closing Day, when the warning signal for the first race will be 1230.

4.3. The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race for the other fleets is 1400, except for 10/16/22, Closing Day, when the warning signal for the first race will be 1300.

4.4. No Warning Signal will be made after 1700.

4.5. Racing for the day will not be *abandoned* prior to 1530 except in cases of extreme weather.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. Sailing instructions for Ensign, Laser, Lightning, Open, Sonar, and Thistle classes are entitled "One Design Sunday Sailing Instructions".

5.2. Sailing instructions for PHRF racing are entitled "PHRF Sunday Sailing Instructions".

5.3. Copies of all sailing instructions will be placed next to the Race Committee locker in the lower level of the Nyack Boat Club and posted on the Nyack Boat Club website.

5.4. In the event of a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will prevail. This changes RRS 63.7.

6. VENUE

The *racing* area will be that part of the Hudson River known as the Tappan Zee, south of Hook Mountain and north of the Tappan Zee Bridge.

7. SCORING

Each fleet will determine its own scoring, based on information from the Race Committee.

8. RADIO COMMUNICATION

While *racing*, a boat shall neither make nor receive radio transmissions not available to all participants, except for emergencies. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones, tablets, computers, etc.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate entirely at their own risk. See RRS Rule 3, *Decision to Race*. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the racing.

10. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall maintain valid third-party liability insurance.
